


PARTICIPATE IN RESEARCH

LOOKING FOR VETERANS WITH A BELOW KNEE AMPUTATION TO PARTICIPATE IN A RESEARCH STUDY

Who are we looking for:

Veterans 18-65 years old, who have a below the knee amputation, who are currently using a prosthesis. Participants must be at least 1 year post-amputation and able to walk comfortably with their prosthesis for 30 minutes. Participants must be free of any serious heart, lung, nervous system disorder, or leg injuries.



What does your participation entail?

Initially, you will be asked to complete a general screening. If you are interested and eligible for the study, you will be asked to complete the consent process and take part in 20 research visits, taking place at the PVAMC. The purpose of this study is to evaluate the effectiveness of a new type of gait training using virtual reality.

Participants will be compensated for their time and effort.
