

TMS for PTSD and Depression

Researchers at the Providence VA Medical Center, lead by Dr. Noah Philip, are conducting a study using a form of brain stimulation called Transcranial Magnetic Stimulation (TMS). They are looking at the effects of this stimulation on patients with Posttraumatic Stress Disorder (PTSD) and Depression. By being in this study you could help improve scientific understanding of the brain, and therefore develop better devices and methods to treating PTSD and depression.

You may be eligible if you have been diagnosed with PTSD and depression and are between the ages of 18 and 70.

If you participate, you will be asked to:

- Fill out questionnaires and complete an interview with a trained study staff member about psychiatric symptoms (up to 3 hours)
- Have an EEG to measure your brain activity
- Receive magnetic stimulation of your brain by stimulating your scalp



You will receive up to \$75 in gift cards if you complete the study
