### **COVID-19 Vaccine Clinic in Swansea MA for all Veterans**

PROVIDENCE, R.I. – The VA Providence Healthcare System will be providing COVID-19 vaccinations to all Veterans on Saturday, March 27, 2021. The clinic will be located at New Hope Church on 1436 Grand Army of the Republic Highway, Swansea MA. The clinic will start at 9am and end at approximately 2pm.

“Give the recent success of our clinic in Middletown we are again using this opportunity to bring vaccination clinics to our Veterans in the areas that they live,” said Larry Connell, Medical Center Director, VA Providence Healthcare System. “In speaking to the Veterans Service Officers of the Southeastern Massachusetts region they were very excited to work with us in making this clinic a reality”.

Veterans who are not enrolled in the VA Healthcare System will need to bring a copy of their DD214 and a picture ID. Additionally, they will need to fill out a 1010EZ enrollment form. The VA Providence Healthcare System continues to vaccinate Veterans, Monday to Friday from 8am to 2pm at the main campus in Providence. Additional vaccination events are being planned, so if you cannot make this clinic there will be others coming soon.
